NYPSI's Treatment Center

Students and candidates at NYPSI receive referrals from NYPSI's Treatment Center. NYPSI's Treatment Center provides low-fee treatment to individuals in the community who couldn't otherwise afford high quality treatment. The Treatment Center offers psychotherapy and psychoanalysis for adults, adolescents, and children. Psychological testing is also available.

Class Schedule

Classes are offered virtually on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 7-8:30PM and 8:30-10PM. Candidates may choose full-time (twice-weekly) or part-time (once-weekly) schedules to accommodate their professional and family commitments.

Financial Aid

Assistance is available to students demonstrating financial need. Fees for supervision are included in the tuition rates.

Diversity and Inclusivity

As an organization, NYPSI places a focus on diversity. This is highlighted by the establishment of the CRCD (Committee on Racial Consciousness and the Diversities). This committee has established study groups that explore race, the psychodynamics of racism, and systemic racism in our society. Additionally, several courses about racism and diversity have been added to our curriculum. We furthermore work to facilitate collaborations with diverse institutes, such as Harlem Family Institute and Montefiore. NYPSI's curriculum and scientific meetings continue to incorporate the growing psychoanalytic understanding of gender and sexuality. Specific classes on gender and pregnancy are offered, and studies of sexual development and identity are explored in development, theory and technique classes.
